### Self Inspection Extension of Contestability Agreement

This Self Inspection Extension of Contestability Agreement is dated2023and made between:2023

- (1) National Grid Electricity Distribution [(South West)/(South Wales)/(East Midlands)/(West Midlands)]\*) plc (company number: 02366894/02366985/02366923/03600574\*) whose registered office is at Avonbank, Feeder Rd, Bristol BS2 0TB ("NGED"); and
- (2) [*Company name*] (company number:[*Company number*]) whose registered office is at [*address*] (the "Connection Provider").

#### Background

- (A) NGED and the Connection Provider have entered into a framework agreement dated [*insert*] (the **"Framework Agreement"**).
- (B) As part of NGED's commitment to the development and facilitation of competition in connections NGED has invited the Connection Provider to take part in this Extension of Contestability Initiative (as defined below in clause 1.2).
- (C) The Connection Provider has agreed to take part in this Extension of Contestability Initiative on the terms and conditions set out in this Self Inspection EOC Agreement (as defined below in clause 1.2).

It is agreed as follows:

#### **1.** Definitions and interpretation

- 1.1 The terms of this Self Inspection EOC Agreement shall be deemed to be incorporated into and form part of the Framework Agreement for the duration of this Self Inspection EOC Agreement. In the event of any conflict between this Self Inspection EOC Agreement and the Framework Agreement, the terms of this Self Inspection EOC Agreement shall prevail over the conflicting terms of the Framework Agreement solely in respect of the subject matter of this Self Inspection EOC Agreement.
- 1.2 In this Self Inspection EOC Agreement, terms have the meanings given to them in the Framework Agreement unless the context requires otherwise and in addition the following definitions shall apply:

"Activities" the activities listed in the inspection regime table contained in the Operating Manual which it is indicated in Schedule SI1 will be carried out by the Connection Provider;

- "Authorised a representative of the Connection Representative" Provider who is sufficiently skilled, trained, qualified and experienced to carry out the Self Inspection Services;
- "Competent" deemed sufficiently competent and skilled to carry out the Self Inspection Services including (but not limited to) having achieved all necessary accreditations and/or certifications under the NERS;
- "Extension of NGED permitting the Connection Contestability Provider to independently carry out the Initiative" Self Inspection Services of those Contestable Assets which are to be Adopted by NGED in accordance with the Framework Agreement;
- "Indemnified Party" NGED, any company in the NGED Group and any of their respective servants and agents;
- "NERS" the Lloyds National Electricity Registration Scheme;
- "**Operating Manual**" Standard Technique ST:NC2N, as published by NGED and updated from time to time;
- "Self Inspection EOC Agreement" this extension of contestability agreement (including any schedules to it) between NGED and the Connection Provider;
- "Self Inspection EOC the date specified on the front sheet of this Self Inspection EOC Agreement; and
- "Self Inspection all such supervision, checks and inspections of the Connection Provider's own performance of the Activities which are necessary to ensure that such Activities have been performed in accordance with NERS, the relevant Policies, relevant Standard Techniques, Applicable Legislation and Good Industry Practice.

- 1.3 In this Self Inspection EOC Agreement, unless the context requires otherwise, the principles of interpretation set out in clause 1.2 of the Framework Agreement shall apply.
- 1.4 Save for clause 4.3, the terms set out below apply solely in respect of this Self Inspection EOC Agreement for the duration of this Self Inspection EOC Agreement.
- 1.5 This Self Inspection EOC Agreement and (to the extent that it applies to this Self Inspection EOC Agreement) the Framework Agreement set out the entire agreement and understanding between the parties in respect of the subject matter of this Self Inspection EOC Agreement.

### 2. **Term**

This Self Inspection EOC Agreement shall be deemed to have commenced on the Self Inspection EOC Commencement Date and shall continue until terminated in accordance with its terms.

#### 3. Self Inspection Services

- 3.1 From the Self Inspection EOC Commencement Date, the Connection Provider shall carry out the Self Inspection Services.
- 3.2 The Connection Provider shall ensure that all Self Inspection Services are at all times carried out:
  - (a) by an Authorised Representative;
  - (b) with all reasonable care and skill;
  - (c) in accordance with:
    - (i) the Operating Manual;
    - (ii) the relevant Policies;
    - (iii) the relevant Standard Techniques; and
    - (iv) Good Industry Practice.
- 3.3 The provisions of the Operating Manual shall govern:
  - (a) the measurement of the Connection Provider's performance of the Self Inspection Services; and
  - (b) NGED's supervision of such performance,

save that in the event of any conflict or inconsistency between the provisions of this Self Inspection EOC Agreement and the Operating Manual, this Self Inspection EOC Agreement shall prevail.

### 4. **Obligations of the Connection Provider**

- 4.1 The Connection Provider shall ensure that the Authorised Representative is Competent.
- 4.2 The Connection Provider acknowledges that NGED shall not be responsible for any loss or damage arising out of or in connection with any breach by the Connection Provider of its obligations in relation to:
  - (a) the Activities; or
  - (b) the Self Inspection Services.
- 4.3 From the Self Inspection EOC Commencement Date, the Defects Correction Period for all Contestable Connection Works (both excavation works and all other works) carried out by the Connection Provider shall be the period set out in the Operating Manual from time to time. This clause 4.3 shall continue in force notwithstanding any subsequent suspension or termination of this Self Inspection EOC Agreement for any reason.

#### 5. Liability and remedies

- 5.1 Subject to sub-clause 23.1 of the Framework Agreement, NGED's liability under this Self Inspection EOC Agreement, whether in contract, tort (including negligence), breach of statutory duty or otherwise, shall not exceed £5,000 (five thousand pounds) per event or series of connected events.
- 5.2 Notwithstanding sub-clause 23.8 of the Framework Agreement, the Connection Provider accepts unlimited liability for and shall indemnify the Indemnified Parties and keep them indemnified against any fine, penalty, charge or similar sum claimed by a regulatory body (and all associated legal costs incurred) from an Indemnified Party due to Self Inspection EOC Default by the Connection Provider under this Self Inspection EOC Agreement.
- 5.3 The Connection Provider will not be liable for loss or damage arising from NGED's negligence or NGED's wilful failure to fulfil its responsibilities under this Self Inspection EOC Agreement.
- 5.4 Subject to sub-clause 23.1 of the Framework Agreement and clause 5.3 of this Self Inspection EOC Agreement, the Connection Provider shall indemnify each Indemnified Party and keep each Indemnified Party indemnified fully at all times against all demands, damages, losses, costs (including reasonable legal costs), expenses and charges arising from:

- (a) damage to the property of an Indemnified Party;
- (b) death or personal injury of any person; and
- (c) all claims by third parties,

caused by or attributable to any act or omission by the Connection Provider in relation to this Self Inspection EOC Agreement.

- 5.5 The Connection Provider undertakes and agrees to take out and maintain all necessary insurance cover in full force and effect at its own cost with an insurance office of repute to cover its liabilities under this Self Inspection EOC Agreement to the extent as would be reasonably expected.
- 5.6 The Connection Provider shall produce at NGED's reasonable request a copy of the insurance policy or policies relating to this Self Inspection EOC Agreement and the relevant renewal receipts for inspection by NGED.
- 5.7 The sum insured shall not be less than £5,000,000 for any one event or series of connected events. The Connection Provider shall not self-insure its liabilities under this Self Inspection EOC Agreement without the written consent of NGED.

### 6. **Force Majeure**

- 6.1 If either party is affected by an Event of Force Majeure, the affected party shall immediately give the other party written notification of the nature and extent of the Event of Force Majeure and the parties shall enter into bona fide discussions with a view to alleviating its effects or to agreeing upon such alternative arrangements as may be fair and reasonable.
- 6.2 If the Connection Provider is affected by an Event of Force Majeure and the written notice in relation to the Event of Force Majeure has not been withdrawn within 7 days, NGED may terminate this Self Inspection EOC Agreement with immediate effect by serving a written notice on the Connection Provider. The service of such notice shall be without prejudice to any rights or obligations which have accrued prior to termination.

#### 7. **Termination**

- 7.1 Without prejudice to any right or remedy either party may have against the other for breach or non-performance of this Self Inspection EOC Agreement, either party may, with immediate effect by notice in writing to the other, terminate this Self Inspection EOC Agreement on or at any time after the happening of any of the following events:
  - (a) on the occurrence of any one or more of the events set out in sub-clauses 33.3(b) to 33.3(h) of the Framework Agreement;

- (b) on the party for any reason whatsoever being substantially prevented from performing or becoming unable to perform its obligations.
- 7.2 Without prejudice to any other right or remedy which it may have, NGED may by notice in writing immediately terminate this Self Inspection EOC Agreement if:
  - (a) any event occurs, or circumstances arise which, in the reasonable opinion of NGED, make it no longer commercially desirable for NGED to continue with the Self Inspection EOC Agreement; or
  - (b) NGED consider termination necessary due to any change in legislation or the conditions of NGED's distribution licence granted pursuant to Section 6(1) (c) of the Electricity Act 1989 or any other legislative requirements.
- 7.3 Without prejudice to any other right or remedy it may have, NGED shall be entitled to suspend or terminate this Self Inspection EOC Agreement in accordance with the provisions of the Operating Manual.
- 7.4 Notwithstanding sub-clause 33.1 of the Framework Agreement, the Connection Provider shall be entitled to terminate this Self Inspection EOC Agreement at any time on not less than three (3) months' prior written notice.

### 8. **Consequences of termination**

- 8.1 All rights and obligations of the parties shall cease to have effect immediately upon termination of this Self Inspection EOC Agreement except that termination shall not affect:
  - (a) the accrued rights and obligations of the parties at the date of termination; and
  - (b) the continued existence and the validity of the rights and obligations of the parties under clauses 4.3, 5, 8, and 10.
- 8.2 Upon termination of this Self Inspection EOC Agreement by NGED for the Operator's breach of the provisions of this Self Inspection EOC Agreement and/or the Operating Manual or clause 7.3, the Connection Provider shall not be permitted to enter into a new agreement with NGED regarding self-inspection of any of its activities for a period of at least 12 months from the effective date of such termination.
- 8.3 On termination of this Self Inspection EOC Agreement by either party for any reason, it shall no longer be deemed incorporated into the Framework Agreement.

#### 9. **Costs and expenses**

Each party shall bear its own costs and expenses incurred in the preparation, execution and implementation of this Self Inspection EOC Agreement.

#### 10. **Data Protection**

NGED may give the Connection Provider the names and addresses of its employees, agents, contractors and sub-contractors. Where NGED does give the Connection Provider any such information the Connection Provider shall keep such information confidential, shall comply with its obligations under the Data Protection Act 1998 in respect of such information and shall only use it for the purpose of performing its obligations under this Self Inspection EOC Agreement.

#### 11. Variation

Notwithstanding clause 36 of the Framework Agreement, the parties shall be entitled to vary Schedule SI1 to this Self Inspection EOC Agreement by agreeing a new schedule in writing (which shall include agreement by email) and substituting such new schedule for Schedule SI1.

#### 12. Entire Agreement

Following the Self Inspection EOC Commencement Date the entire agreement clause in the Framework Agreement shall be deemed (without affecting any previously agreed variations which are still in force) to be varied for the duration of this Self Inspection EOC Agreement to include reference to this Self Inspection EOC Agreement and the documents referred to in it forming part of the Framework Agreement. For the duration of this Self Inspection EOC Agreement this Self Inspection EOC Agreement shall be read and construed together with the Framework Agreement. In the event of any conflict between this Self Inspection EOC Agreement and the Framework Agreement, the terms of this Self Inspection EOC Agreement shall prevail over the conflicting terms of the Framework Agreement solely in respect of the subject matter of this Self Inspection EOC Agreement.

**This Self Inspection EOC Agreement** has been signed on the date stated as the "Date of this Agreement" on page 1 of this Self Inspection EOC Agreement.
